

Payment Plans and In-House Financing



NVLET recognizes that there may be certain situations in which our students are unable to pay in full for their tuition and are unable to use credit or secure a loan. For these students, we've structured the following in-house financing options:

This payment plan is being used to pay for my (circle one) Esthetics Program / Master Esthetics Program

- Option 1:** No financing required, student is paying in full. Total paid: \$7900
- Option 2:** 12 Month Financing-This program requires a \$2000 down payment (\$1000 deferred until the last payment) and 11 installments of \$575 and a final payment of \$1575. Total Paid: **\$8900**
- Option 3:** 24 Month Financing-This program requires a \$3000 down payment (\$2000 deferred and divided between the 12th and 24th payments) and 22 installments of \$288 with a 12th payment of \$1288 and the 24th and final payment of \$1288. Total Paid after 24 months: **\$9900**
- Option 4:** Pay as you go- \$1000 down payment with **weekly** payments of \$299.
OR Pay as you go-\$1000 down payment with **monthly** payments of \$1,150.
Check, cash, or credit card payment is due the **1st class day** of each week/month.

For financing options 2 and 3, payments are due by the 1st of each month. Late payments will be charged a fee of \$25 per day ____ (initial). All payment plans require a primary and secondary method of payment ____ (initial). If your bank or credit card information changes, we require this new information in writing, 2 weeks before your account is to be billed ____ (initial).

Should your account become delinquent beyond 30 days, we reserve the right to expel you and hand your account over to collections ____ (initial). You are financially responsible for any fees incurred by NVLET associated with the procuring of legal assistance, court costs, etc. to obtain your delinquent payments ____ (initial).

This agreement is binding and covers your down payment as well as your monthly payments ____ (initial).
